Cover showing a 10 centavos de peso yellow brown bisected stamp used as 5 c. de peso to pay the single weight letter rate from Santiago de Cuba to Habana. The stamp is tied by a 6 bar oval cancellation. Note that even though the cover bears no year date, the stamp can be identified Scott No.98—and not similar Scott No.127—because of the heavy brown line surrounding the medallion, which is thinner in the later issue.

Folded letter dated at Havana on 1 February 1881 franked with a 10c. yellow brown stamp to pay the single weight letter rate to Veracruz, México. The stamp is tied by an oval magenta CORREOS de MEXICO, VAPOR CITY OF ALEXANDRIA cancellation with a picture of the steamship "City of Alexandria" in the center.
