



Identical franking on domestic and international single weight letters. The 5c rate for single weight letters to the U.S. and Canada was the same as for Cuban domestic single weight letters.

1882 KING ALFONSO XII ISSUE

2 c. lake bisect on cover



Small cover franked with a 2 c. de peso lake bisected stamp tied by an almost illegible circular date stamp. A few discernible letters in the postmark suggest that the cover may have originated in the town of Guanajay near the city of Habana to where it is addressed. The 2 c. de peso bisected stamp used as 1 c. de peso seems to indicate that due to its small size the cover was charged the same rate as a postal card traveling a short distance.
