



A remarkable grouping of 10 c. blue bisected stamps on cover. Included are one tied by purple oval cancellation "ESTAFETA CERRO Y Js. DEL MONTE - HABANA", a number "12" New York Incoming Foreign Mail oval cancellation, a cover with a Matanzas cds and a rare oval "LISTA" mark, and two covers with a pair of bisected stamps, indicating that the use of bisects at this time was so common that they may have been precut and pairs used in lieu of a whole stamp.

Four 10 c. blue Scott No. 130 stamps and a bisect of the same stamp used as 5 cents for total postage of 45 cents on a registered cover from Alquizar, Cuba to Elizondo, Pamplona, Spain. Signed acknowledgement of receipt in good order appears on the back of the cover.
