A pair of $\ 2\ 1/2\ \text{centavos}$ de peso violet stamps paying the single weight letter rate from Matanzas to Habana. The letter is dated 9 September 1884 and bears a Habana receipt backstamp of 10 Sept.



 $2\,$ 1/2 c. olive bistre and $2\,$ 1/2 c. violet stamps used to pay the rate for circulars mailed within the city of Manzanillo (top) and within the city of Habana (bottom).



Two 2 1/2c red brown Alfonso XIII stamps added to three 5c emerald Alfonso XIII stamps to complete the 20c double weight rate for a letter mailed to Paris, France. The cover is postmarked 1 DEC 1894 which is a very late date of use for the Alfonso XIII stamps.
