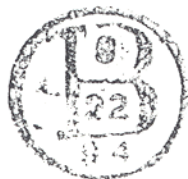

Registered letter to the U.S.



Letter from Santiago de Cuba to New York franked with eight 2½c. stamps paying the 5c. registry fee and three times the single weight letter rate. The letter is postmarked at Santiago on 15 Sep 1894—a rather late usage of these 1890 issue stamps. There is a light magenta rectangular registry mark from Santiago de Cuba on the front of the letter and a magenta New York receipt postmark of 22 Sep 1894 on the back.
