Domestic mail cover franked with a bisected 10c. stamp that was not recognized as valid postage and was stamped with a black "T" indicating postage due should be collected from the recipient. The use of bisected stamps was prevalent in the Alfonso XII issues, but was rare during the time of the Alfonso XIII issues.
