This variety occurs in column 6, row 8 of the center pane of the three pane sheet in which this value was printed. Sheets contained 200 stamps arranged horizontally in panes of 60 (6 columns by 10 rows), 80 (8 x 10), and 60 (6 x 10), with the panes separated by gutters the width of one stamp. The horizontal pair of 5c. stamps on this cover paid the double weight letter rate from Cuba to New York. The cover was sent from an undetermined town in Cuba via Habana and Tampa to New York.
