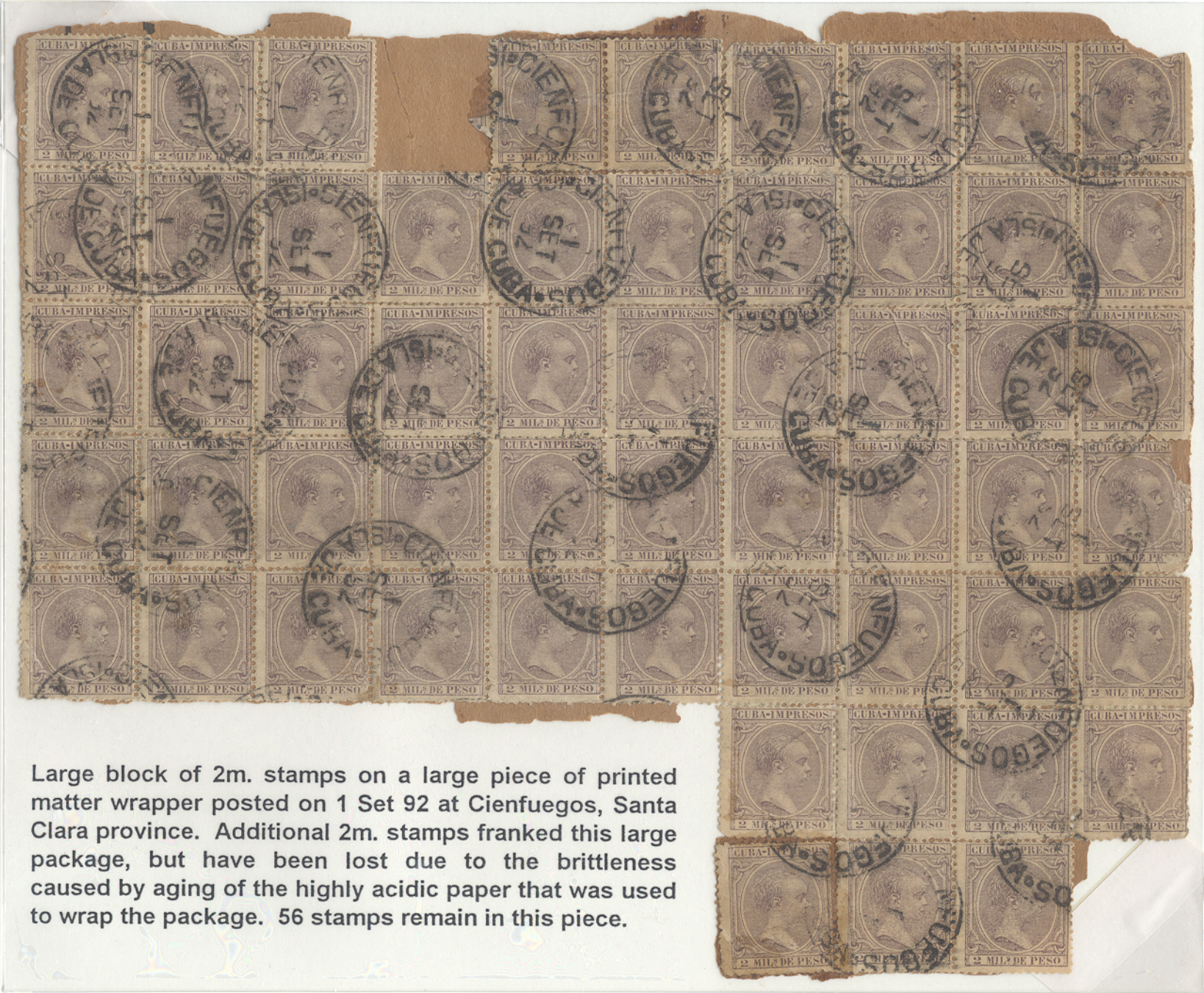


1892 KING ALFONSO XIII ISSUE

Blocks
 "Impresos"— Newspaper Stamps



Note the lack of inking that is most noticeable on the bottom frame lines of the first and last rows of this block of 15 of 8 milésimas stamps resulting from improper placement of the clichés during printing.



Large block of 2m. stamps on a large piece of printed matter wrapper posted on 1 Set 92 at Cienfuegos, Santa Clara province. Additional 2m. stamps franked this large package, but have been lost due to the brittleness caused by aging of the highly acidic paper that was used to wrap the package. 56 stamps remain in this piece.

Header block of 20 stamps of the 1892 3 milésimas violet newspaper stamps. These stamps were printed in panes of 100 stamps (10 rows of 10 stamps each) and were used to pay various printed matter rates.
