Commercial letter postmarked on 17 July 1895 at La Habana and sent to Boston, Massachusetts, via New York. The letter was franked with a horizontal pair of 1c. stamps insufficiently paying the 5c. single weight letter rate to the U.S. by 3c. and was thus charged 3c. postage due and 3c. postage due penalty upon delivery.
