Two letters franked with a pair of 2½c. 1894 stamps paying the 5c. single weight letter rate to the U.S. The top letter went from Cienfuegos to Philadelphia via La Habana and New York in February 1996. The stamps in the bottom letter received a New York "12" foreign mail cancellation upon the arrival of the letter from La Habana on 26 May 1995.
