20c. de peso violet, double weight rate La Habana to Montevideo, Uruguay Via New York









Letter from La Habana to Montevideo, Uruguay, sent via New York franked with a 20c. stamp paying double the 10c. single weight letter rate to Uruguay. The letter was postmarked at La Habana on or around 11 Aug 1896 and is backstamped with a New York "Foreign Transit" mark and a 2 Sep 1896 Montevideo receipt postmark.



Registered cover from Habana to Puerto Príncipe, Camagüey province, franked with a 10c. emerald stamp and a 20c. violet stamp for a total of 30c. The cover has a manuscript "Cetificada A. R." indicating that it is a registered letter with a request for acknowledgement of receipt ("A. R." corresponding to the French "Accusé de Réception"), but bears no postal registry markings. The 30c. postage paid the 5c. registry fee plus 5 times the single weight letter rate of 5c.

Registered letter from La Habana to Brussels, Belgium, franked with a 20c. violet stamp paying double the 10c. single weight letter rate to Belgium, plus 1c, 2c, and  $2\frac{1}{2}$ c stamps paying the 5c registry fee. The letter was postmarked at La Habana on 10 Nov 1897, bears an undetermined 24 Nov transit mark on front to the left of a rectangular purple registry mark, and is backstamped with a Brussels receipt postmark of 25 Nov.
