Cover franked with two 2c. and one 6c. de peso stamps paying the double weight letter rate from La Habana to New York via Tampa. The letter has a partial New York 1898 receipt postmark and the printed sender's name from Habana.

6 centavos dark blue U.S. Administration Period



Covers franked with two and one 6c. stamps paying the double and single weight letter rates to the U.S. during the U.S. postal administration which imposed corresponding 2c. and 1c. penalties on double and single weight letters franked with Cuban stamps. Both covers bear illegible Habana datestamps, but have clear New York post office receipt backstamps of 29 Nov and 8 Sep 1898 respectively.

The cover bears an up-side-down black rectangular registry mark that reads "ISLA DE CUBA—HABANA—VIA EXTRANJERA".
