

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Cuba

Issue of January 1, 1890

Alfonso XII died November 12, 1890. His son Alfonso XIII was born in Madrid in April 1886. Maria Christina, the wife of Alfonso XII, and mother of Alfonso XIII ruled by a regency at this time.

This issue is of a new design. It is a portrait of the Baby King and is called "Baby" in English and "Pelón" (Badly) in Spanish. The dies were engraved by Eugenio Julia y Jover. Typographed by Fabrica Nacional de Sellos, Madrid, on white, wove paper, unwatermarked and perforation 14. Printed in sheets of 200, aranged horizontally is panes of 60 (60x10), 80 (8x10) and 60 (6x10), separated by gutters the width of one stamp. There are two gutters in a sheet.

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Issue of the Revolutionary Government in 1897.

The Revolutionary Government in Cuba, authorized on September 7, 1896, the printing of this issue. The Minister Plenipotentiary in the U. S., Thomas Estrada Palma, Commissioned the printing. The Kendall Bank Note Co. engraved the plates, and the New York Bank Note Co. printed the stamps. As in 1874, the stamps were to serve two purposes: to pay postage on mail in the territory held by the Revolutionary Government, which by 1898 was almost all of the interior of the island; and to serve as a propaganda and fund raiser.
