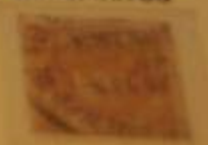

PAIR IMPERFORATE BETWEEN



Queen Isabel II was deposed by the revolution of September 18, 1868. The 1869 telegraph stamps were overprinted "HABILITADO POR LA NACION" using black or blue ink. The overprint was applied by hand. Depending on the height of the first "A" of Habilitado there are two types of overprint, type 1 and type 2.

TELEGRAPHIC STAMPS OF CUBA DURING THE SPANISH ADMINISTRATION

1898

New design for telegraph and postage stamps with a portrait of King Alfonso XIII. This issue coincided with the Spanish Decree granting Cuba a self government, for this reason is known as "Issue of Autonomy". The dies were engraved by Bartolomé Maura, and the issue was typographed by the Fábrica Nacional de Sellos de Madrid. Perforation 14. Unwatermarked. Twenty values.
