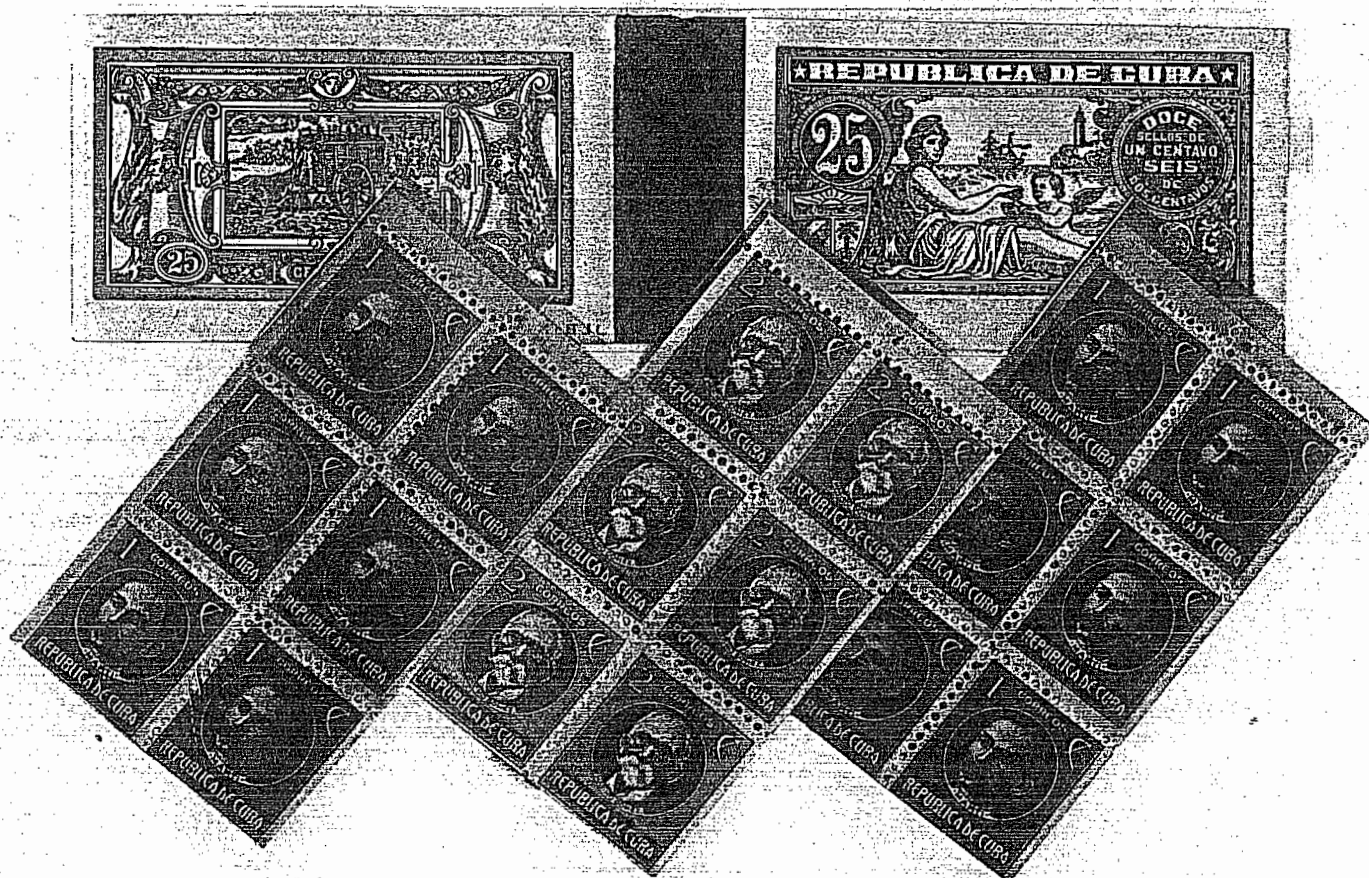
1917 - Booklet of the 1 Cent value of postage issue for this year.

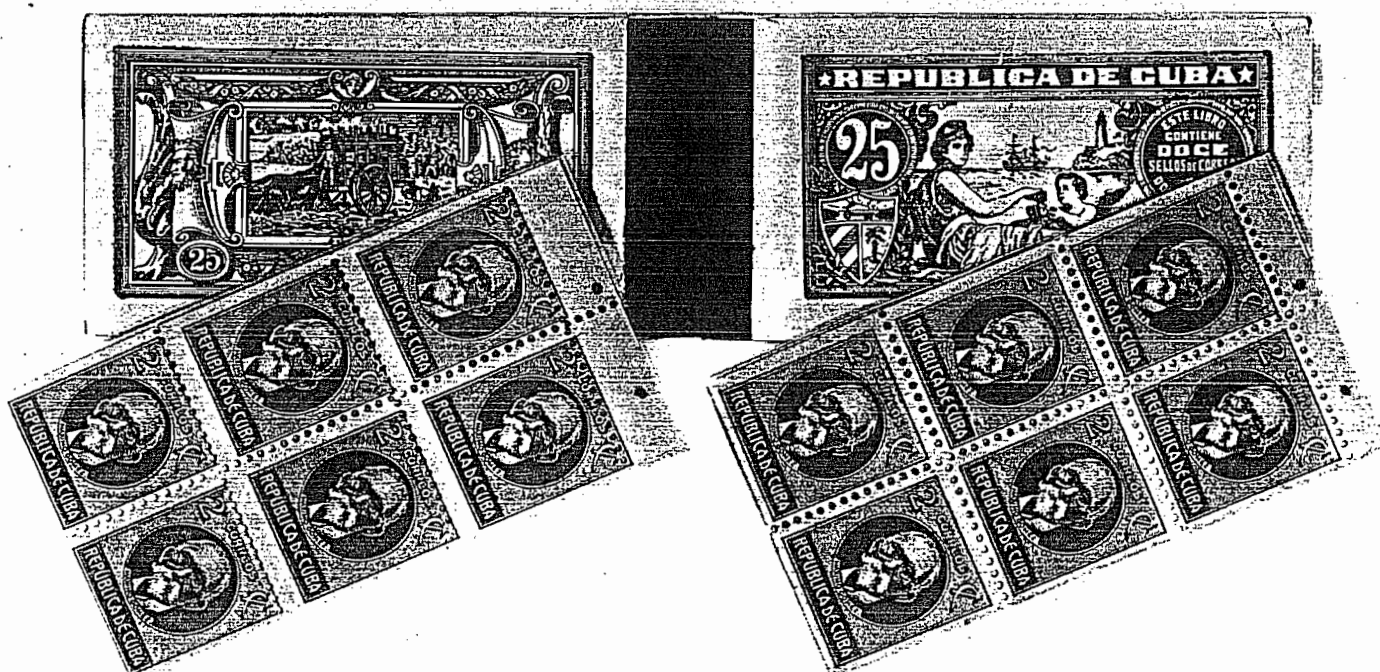




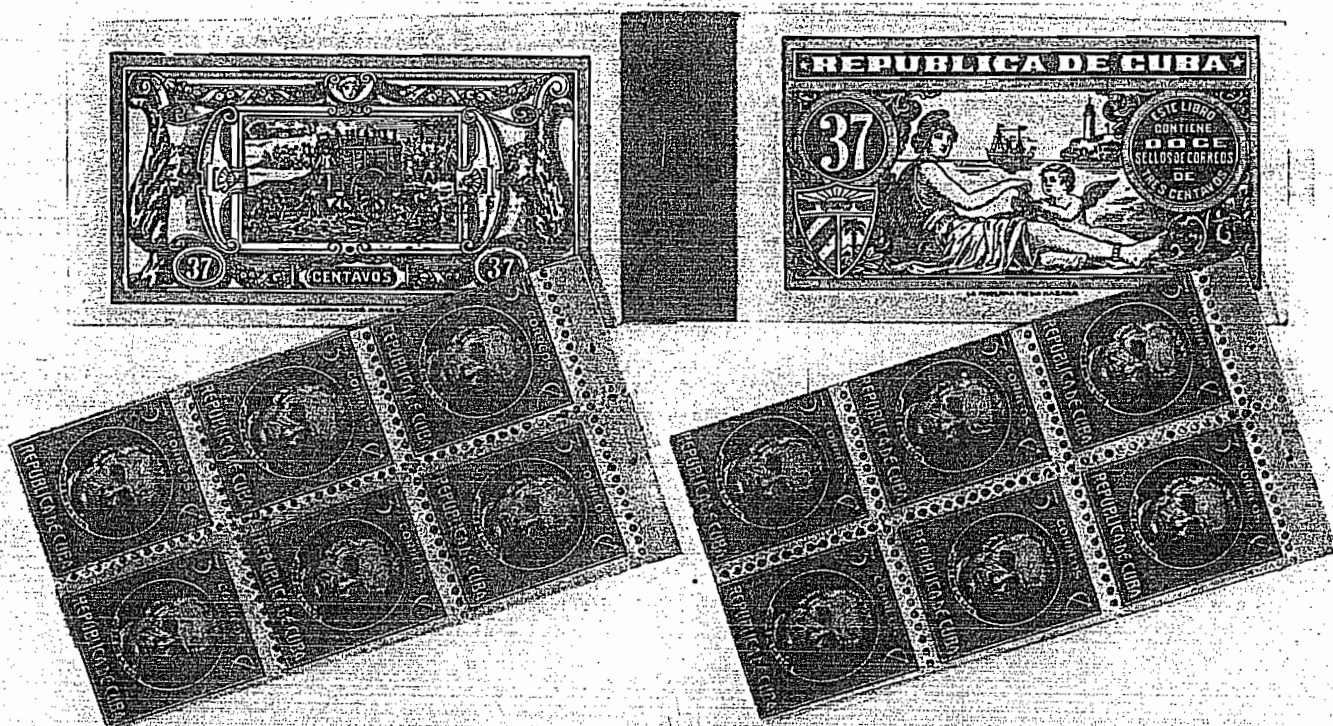
1917 - Combination booklet containing two 6-stamp panes of the 1c. value, as well as one pane of the 2c. stamps. Perf. 12, unwatermarked.



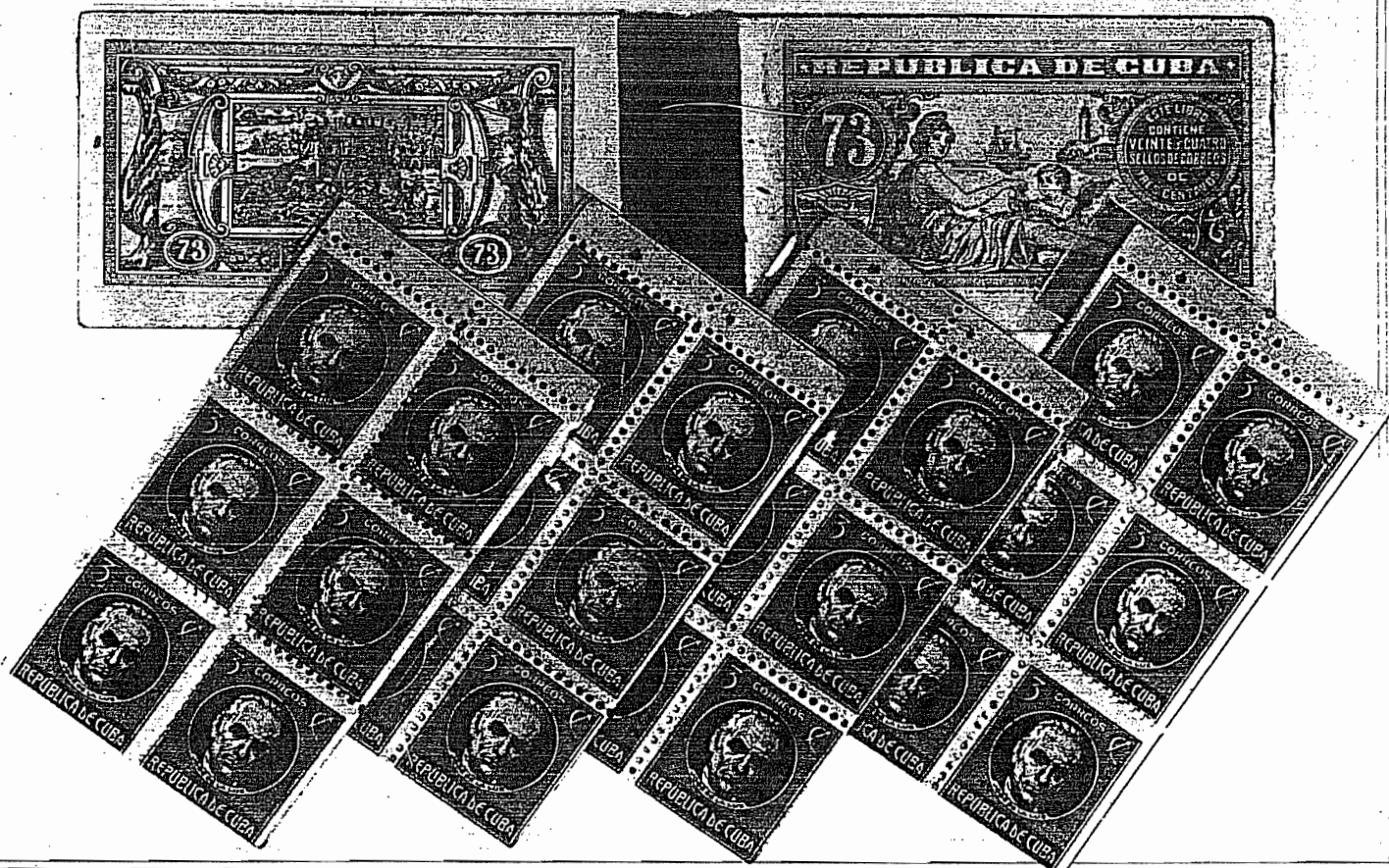
1917 - Booklet of the 2 Cent value, containing two 6-stamp panes, plus a one cent charge for the book. Perforation 12, unwatermarked.

Perforation 12, unwatermarked.

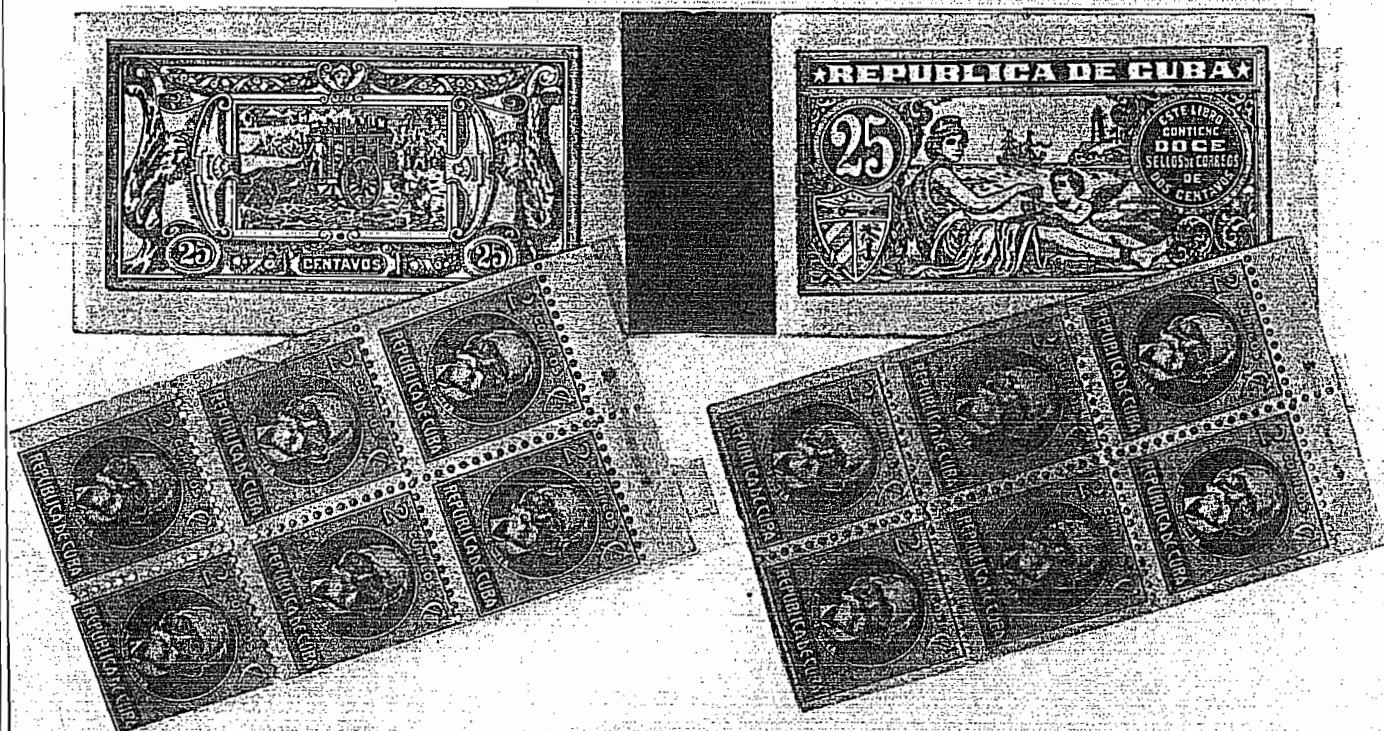


1917 - Booklet of the 3 Cent value, having four 6-stamp panes of same.  
Perforation 12, unwatermarked.

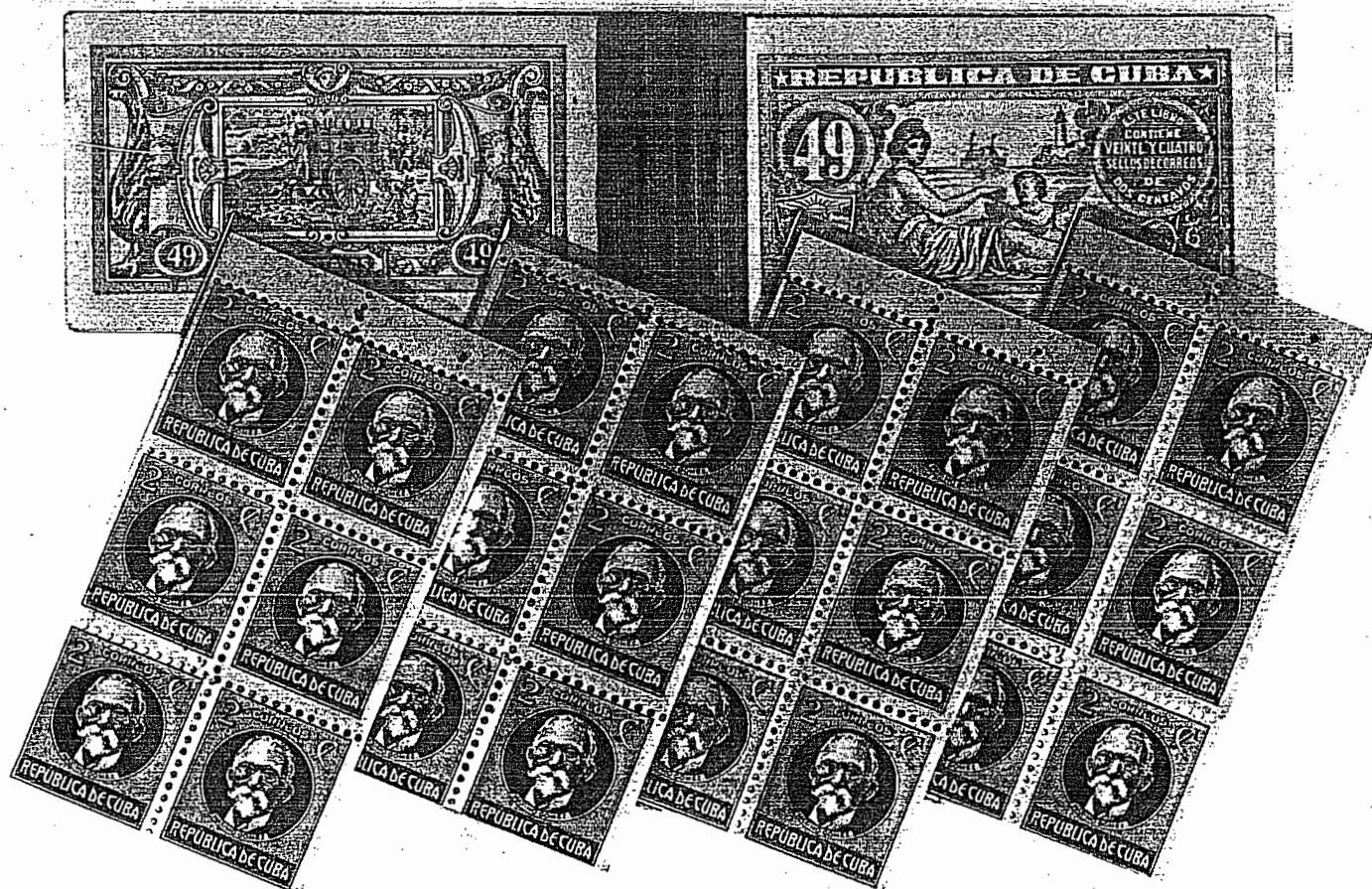




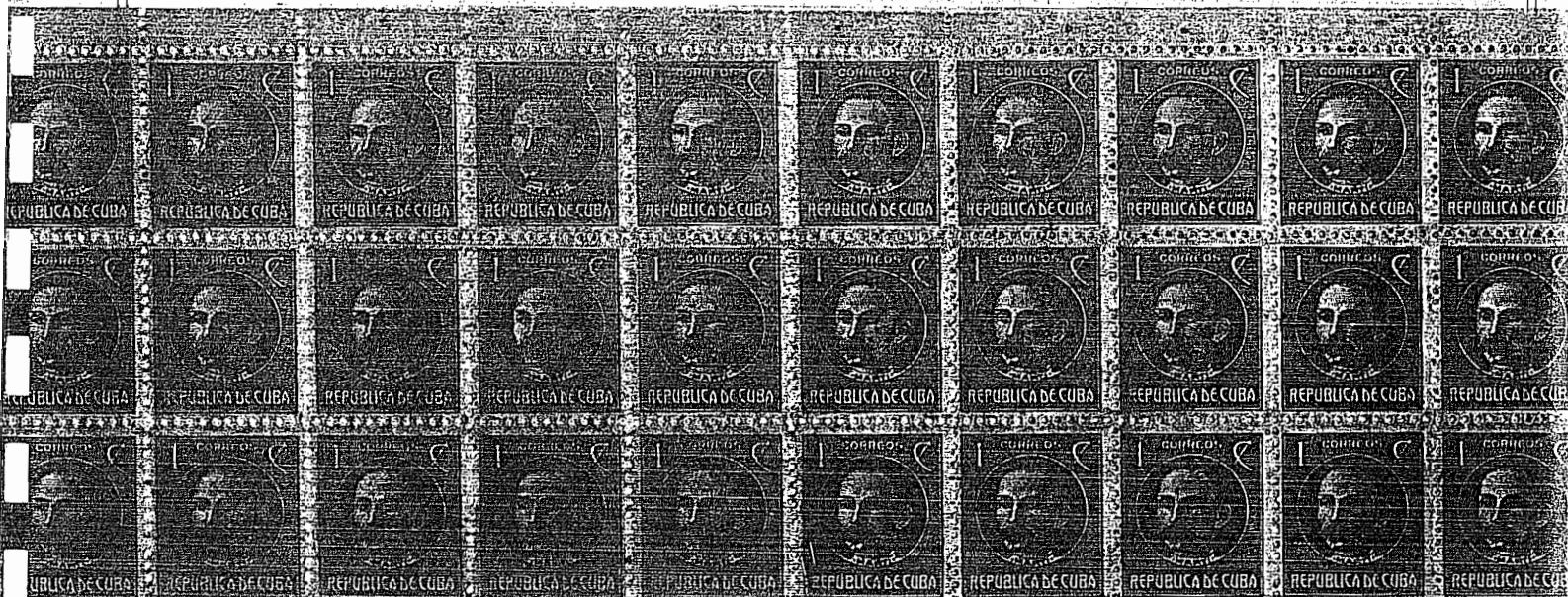
1925 - Booklet of the 2 Cent value with two 6-stamp panes, plus a cent charge for the book. Perforation is 12, and watermarked "STAR".



1925 - Booklet of the 2 Cent value with four 6-stamp panes, plus a one cent charge for the book. Perforation is 12, and watermarked "STAR".

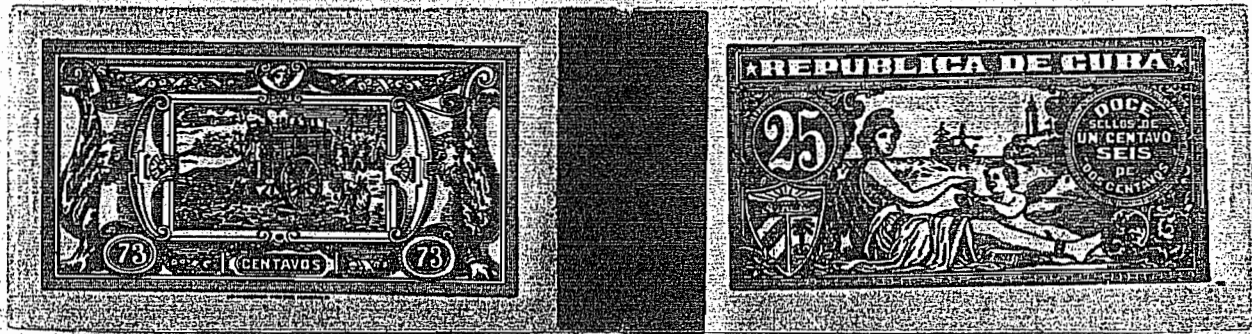


1925 - Booklet panes of 30 stamps from the larger booklets used by the mailmen.
