





1910 - Inverted centers from the issue of the Patriots of the War for Independence.





1912, June 4th. - Registered cover showing the 10c. stamp for this rate.  
Also in purple, an oval "A.R." which is the mark for "return receipt".




1914 - Issue known as "MAPITAS" for postage use. The blocks shown below are IMPERFORATED. Of the 50c. and \$1 values only one sheet of each (100 stamp sheet) is known to exist imperforated.





1928 - Commemorative Issue of the Sixth Pan-American Conference, held in Havana. Below is shown the 10Cent value of this issue IMPERFORATED on "STAR" watermarked paper. This is the first pair ever reported of this error.

1933 - Commemorative Overprinted Issue by the newly established Revolutionary Government, to celebrate the overthrow of the Machado regime. Shown below are VARIETIES in the overprints in red.









1935 - Postal Tax Issue to help cover the costs of the First Air Train.  
Shown is the ERROR of the DOUBLE surcharge.


1942 - Postal tax stamp of the 1941 Issue for the benefit of the National Council of Tuberculosis. Overprinted in black "1942". The block below shows the error of the INVERTED SURCHARGE: "1942"



1944 - Commemorative of the 450th Anniversary of the Discovery of America by Christopher Columbus. Shown is the 1c. value in a block of four ERROR IMPERFORATED IN BETWEEN HORIZONTALLY: only found in used condition.



1951 - Commemorative of the "El Morillo" action, where Dr. Antonio Guiteras lost his life. Shown is the souvenir sheet with the ERROR of INVERTED LEGEND.



1952 - Commemorative Issue of the execution of the University Students by the Spaniards. Shown is the sheet numbered strip with the error being imperforated in-between on the 1c. value. Only a miniature sheet of 25 stamps (5x 5) has ever been reported with this error. This strip is one fifth of that sheet.



1952 - Issue Commemorating the 50th. Anniversary of the Republic. Shown is the 8c. airmail value with the ERROR IMPERFORATED BETWEEN HORIZONTALLY. This is the only strip ever reported; it is USED .



1952 - Issue Commemorating the 50th. Anniversary of the Republic.  
Shown is the 10c. value of the set with the ERROR imperforated in-between. Only the bottom row of one sheet is known to have missed the perforation, and only a strip of 10 is known. Here is 3/10 of it.



1953 - The 2c. value originally from the Tobacco Issue of 1948, is here shown overprinted for 3c. due to an increase in the domestic rates. The error of the inverted surcharge is shown below. Only a few examples of this error have been reported, and all known copies are found only in used condition.






1956 - Issued in Honor of Our Lady of Cobre, Patroness of Cuba. Shown is the ERROR where the YELLOW color has been omitted.





1957 - Christmas Issue depicting a Nativity Scene. Shown below are normal blocks of the two values of this set. Along side of them are the ERRORS of missing colors.

1957 - Aerogramme - The error shown is that of the omission of the  
BLUE color, which resulted in the missing frame and the wording of  
"VIA AEREA - AEROGRAMME." Also the paper itself is tinted  
in ROSE, a variety. Below is shown a normal First Day Aerogramme.





1960 - Stamp of the 20 Centavos value from the Issue of 1945. It has been surcharged and devalued to be used as a 10 Centavos. Shown are varieties in the overprint.
