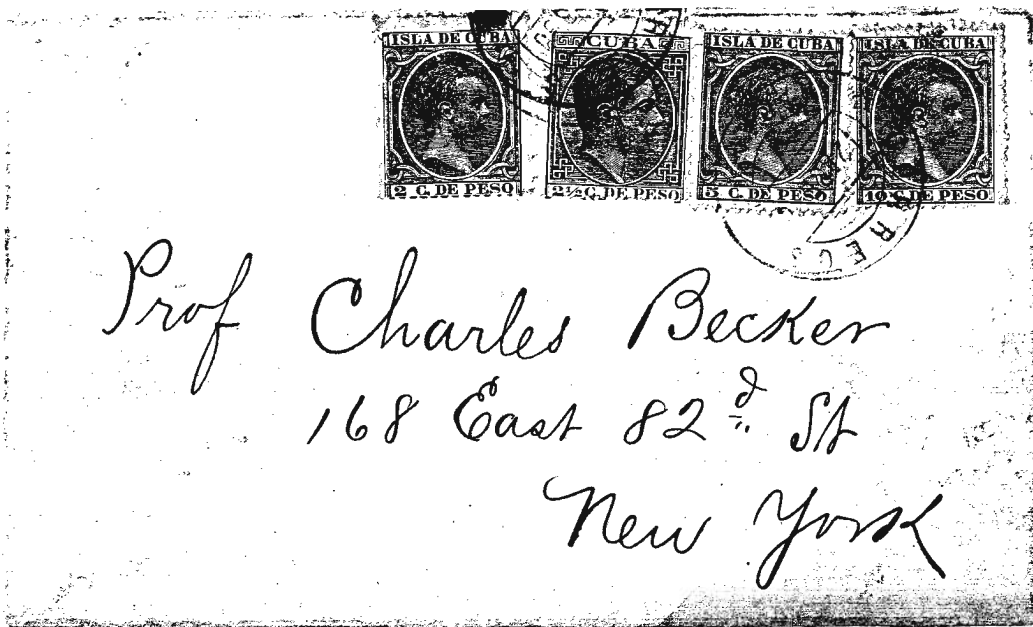

An outer wrapper used from Santo Domingo to Colon in Cuba, paying a five times rate.

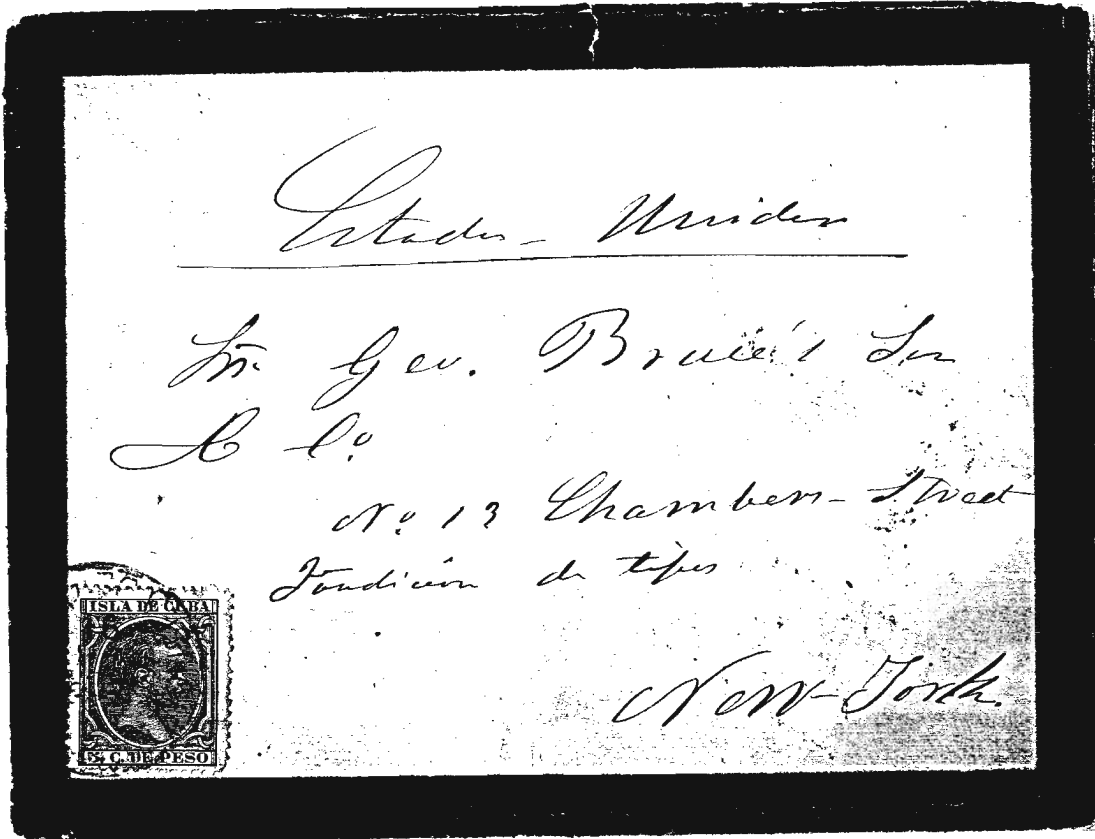

The first issue of Alfonso XIII paying the 5 centavos rate to New York, Feb. 15, 1890.

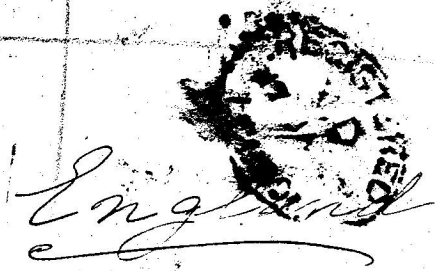
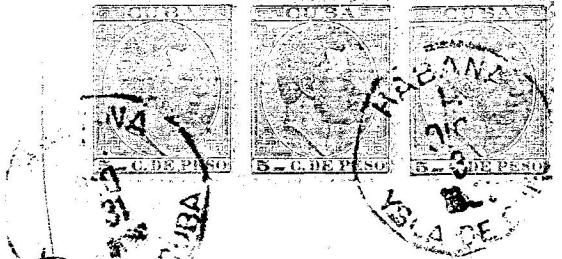
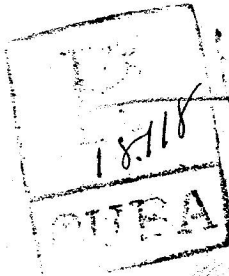

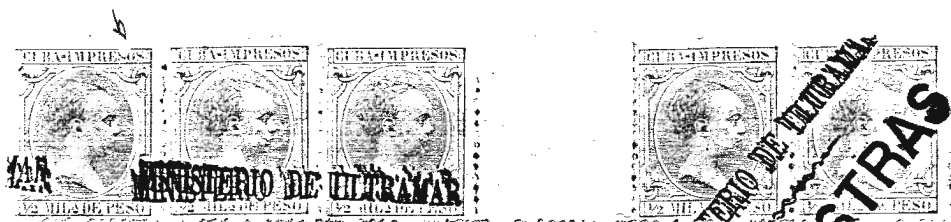
