

As of January 1898, a new design was adopted showing a more mature picture of the 'boy' king. The block below is a plate proof on the only value known as a proof, and is handstamped, 'F M T' for 'Fabrica de Moneda y Timbre', the Spanish equivalent of our Bureau Of Engraving and Printing. It is imperforate, the only way found.



While this cover was sent in October of 1898, and received at Madrid in November, all were valid for postage, although a penalty for using Spanish issues applied.



A single 2 centavos stamp paying the double drop letter rate within Havana.



Underpaid by 1c., the 5 centavos rate to the U.S. with the addressee having to pay the penalty rate of  $2\phi$ , as shown by the U.S. postage due stamp, under U.P.U. regulations.

Underpaid 5 centavos rate to the United States; the addressee was charged twice the 1 centavo due, as was the regulation under the U.P.U. standards then in use.



Ten copies of the  $\frac{1}{2}$  centavo(5 milesimas)stamp paying the five c. rate to Brooklyn.










The fifteen centavos value in a full sheet showing the value flaw in position 23.






