- 196 **Official, 1883-85** 1c. (3), 2c., 10c., 40c., **double or inverted overprints**, majority unused, some have faults 6
- 197 — 1886 set of four in pairs, showing both types of overprint (02 and 03) and type 04 5c., 10c., all unused or mint 10
- 198 — ditto type 05, error "OFICAL" 1c., 2c., 40c., the last in a strip with two normals, also variety **no stop** 2c., and 2c., pair, one stamp with **overprint omitted**, all unused or mint 8
- 199 — 1887 5c., overprinted **back and front**, 5c. and 10c. in strips of three, centre stamp "OFICAL.", and 10c., three pairs showing **double overprint, no stop**, and "OFICIAL", all unused or mint 13
- 200 — 1903 2c. with green overprint, two mint pairs and a single showing varieties "PROVSIORIO", "PROVISIORO" inverted, and "PROVISIORO". Cat. £11 12s. 5
- 201 — ditto 2c. black and vermilion, variety **overprinted in black**, S.G. 354c., mint. Cat. £12 1
- 202 — 1908 2c., 5c., 1col., 2col., variety **centre inverted**, unused with part gum 4
- 203 — 1920 to 1921 **surcharged**, error "1291" on 4c., and seven inverted, two of them in pair with normal 10
- 204 — **The valuable collection** with a good range of 1883 to 1887 issues, complete sets to 1926, all unused or mint 75
- 205 — **Another collection** to 1923, nearly all unused or mint, strong in early overprints, also shades and varieties 78
- 206 **GUANACASTE: The good collection**, nearly all unused or mint and including scarce values 48

(Under Spanish, United States and Republican rule.)

- 207 1855 "Y $\frac{1}{4}$ " on 2r. deep carmine, S.G. 5, a mint block of twelve (4 x 3) with lower sheet margin, touched at right and two creases, but fine and very rare (see photo, plate VI) 12
- 208 1857 "Y $\frac{1}{4}$ " on 2r. rose-red, S.G. 14, a very fine unused **block of nine** (3 x 3), has two minute thin spots 9
- 209 **The collection** to 1869, majority unused or mint, containing complete sets, shades and a few scarce 60

- 210 **1883 ornamental overprints**, the valuable collection, majority unused or mint, containing numerous errors and varieties, also sheets 5c. (2) and 10c., error "10" on 20c. (5, one inverted) 372
- 211 — ditto 5c., three sheets showing different settings, 10c. sheet, 20c. sheet, and 20c. block of 45 in a deeper shade and with surcharge misplaced, mint 545
- 212 **The good collection**, issues from 1870 to 1898, majority unused or mint and in complete sets, also a few varieties 155
- 213 **1899 1c. on 1m. chestnut**, S.G. 1, horizontal **strip of three** used on piece, centre stamp variety broken "1", and 10c. on 1c. plum, S.G. 74, mint horizontal strip of five, one stamp with the same variety 8
- 214 **1899 3c. on 1m. chestnut**, mint horizontal pair, comprising both types, S.G. 5, 6, has trace of crease. Cat. £70 (see photo, plate V) 2
- 215 — 3c. on 1m. chestnut, S.G. 5, unused and slightly soiled, and 5c. on 5m. chestnut, S.G. 18, fine unused with part gum 2
- 216 — 5c. on 5m. chestnut, horizontal pair, comprising both types, S.G. 17, 18, unused with part gum and fine (see photo, plate V) 2
- 217 — 3c. on 2m. green, S.G. 32, fine used on small piece. Cat. £25 (see photo, plate V) 1
- 218 — 5c. on 4m. green, S.G. 48, used, perfs. irregular and off-centre, but rare. Cat. \$400 (see photo, plate V) 1
- 219 — 5c. on 8m. green, S.G. 49, used on small piece and very fine but for creased corner perf. (see photo, plate V) 1
- 220 — **Various used and unused**, comprising S.G. 1, 2 (broken "1"), 4, 3 and 4 in a pair, 10, 37, 70, 71, 73, 74 11
- 221 **1902 1c. on 3c. purple varieties surcharge inverted and surcharge double**, S.G. 7, 7a, both unused with large part gum 2
- 222 **1910 2c. green and carmine, variety centre inverted**, mint and very fine. Cat. £25 (see photo, plate VI) 1
- 223 — 2c. green and carmine, the same variety used and lightly cancelled, slightly off-centre to left but fine. Cat. £30 1
- 224 — 10c. blue and sepia, variety centre inverted, mint and very fine. Cat. £35 (see photo, plate VI) 1

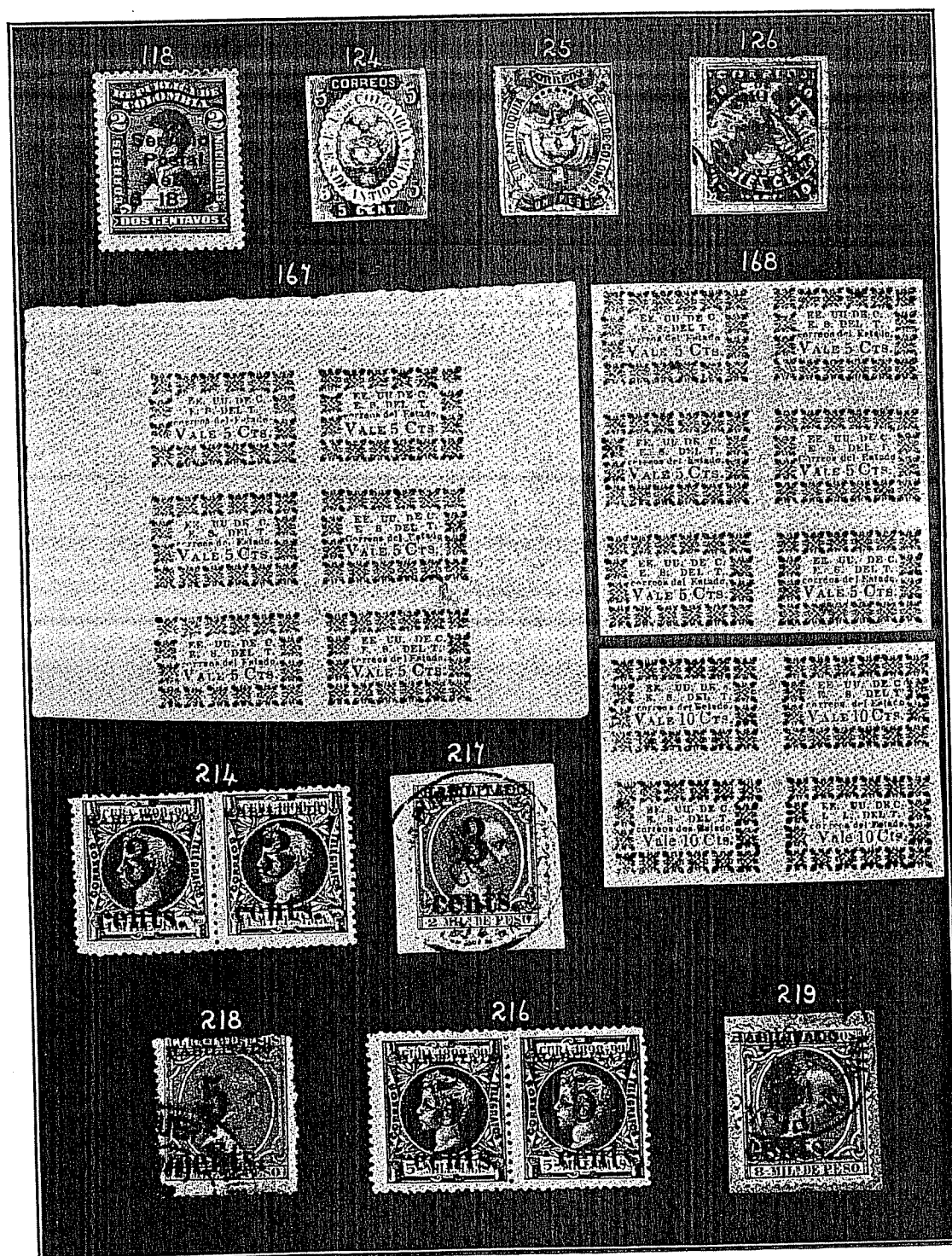
