 310 327 — 1c on 3c the variety without "Habilitado," very scarce, unused, o. g., straight edge at left

 210 330 Newspaper 1894  $\frac{1}{2}$ m rose, imperf. pair, unused, o. g. from upper right hand corner of sheet, with imprint

## Puerto Principe.

240 338 2c on 2m, unsevered pair showing both types (Nos. 178 and 179) with military cancellation 7 00

475 339 — Two fine used pairs, in distinct shades, light brown and dark brown (Nos. 178 and 179) 14 00

425 340 — Strip of 5 used, containing four of No. 178 and one of No. 179. The stamps singly catalogue \$13, but such a strip as this is worth far more

825 342 2c on 2m inverted surcharge (No. 178a), perfs. close at right 25 00

375 343 3c on 3m, unsevered pair lightly cancelled, showing both types (Nos. 180 and 181) 11 00

900 344 3c on 3m inverted surcharge (No. 180a), a finely centered used copy of a scarce stamp

250 345 3c on 3m, scarce type (No. 181) 7 50

775 346 5c on 1m (No. 182), perfs. close at right, but a very satisfactory copy as the surcharge does not cover the numeral 25 00

225 347 5c on 5m (No. 188), off centre at right 10 00

14.00 348 5c on 5m inverted surcharge (No. 188a). This stamp is priced at \$30 in the catalogue, which is only three times the price of the normal variety, whereas any Puerto Principe invert is worth from 6 to 10 times the price of the normal variety

800 349 5c on 5m, scarce type (No. 189), finely centered and lightly canceled copy 25 00

260 350 5c on 1m (No. 190), well centered 7 50

375 351 — Finely centered used pair of same (No. 190) 15 00

425 352 5c on 1m scarce type (No. 191), lightly canceled, well centered 12 50

7.75 353 5c on 1m strip of three, the center stamp being the scarce type, used on piece of cover (Nos. 190 and 191) 27 50

25.00 354 5c on 1m scarce type, inverted surcharge (No. 191a), one of the rarities of this issue
