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Let's do some more simple arithmetic.

I count six quarter page advertisements in each of the last two issues of the Society journal. At \$150 per quarter page advertisement, as indicated in the inside front cover of the journal, that comes to \$900. However, I notice that the last two Treasurer's Reports, published in issues Nos.55 and 56 of the Society's journal, show no advertising income. As a matter of fact, the Treasurer's Report published in El Boletín No.71 is also missing any advertising income. The total period covered by these reports is two years from 1 July 2007 to 1 July 2009. Why has the Society not collected any advertising fees for the last two years?

And please note, before I'm accused of any implications of any financial irregularities that there is no intent on my part to imply anything—I'm just making a statement of fact and would like an explanation.
