The index does include the names of all Cuban post offices that are known to have existed and is thus a valuable tool that can be used to identify the full name of a post office for which only a partial spelling is available from a partial cancellation on a stamp or cover by using the "Find" command of your browser with the partial spelling to locate all possible candidates for the post office. The index includes the index of The Cuban Philatelist Nos.1 to 50 that was prepared by Dr. Yamil H. Kouri and was published as part of issue No.50 of the journal. The citations in that index appear in the form of Volume Number, Issue Number, and page range for each cited article and are incorporated as such in this index.
