This article provides an overview of these datestamps that were in use in Cuba during the last decade of the Spanish Administration starting from 1888 to 1898 and even into the U.S. Administration period until they were replaced by U.S. type datestamps. The overview is followed by an inventory of the known examples of these numbered datestamps identifying for each their earliest and latest known dates of use. The general format of the datestamp is illustrated, but no actual images of any of the datestamps are provided. The intent of the article was to generate interest in these datestamps and to solicit further examples of these datestamps from the public. Lot #255 was a used 1899 2c. inverted surcharge on a 2c. U.S. postage due stamp that did not sell. The rest of the Dr. Yamil H. Kourí, Jr. collection of Puerto Príncipe Surcharged Issues was sold in Sale 992 and consisted of a substantial holding of the five printings of these issues, but did not include any covers since all covers in the collection had been sold in the previous Sale 989. The 64 lots of stamps that were sold in this second sale realized a total of \$33,410, bringing the combined total realized by the two parts of Dr. Kourí's Puerto Príncipe Collection to \$124,860, not including the 15% sale commission.

This last practice was more common in the 19th century. The major American ports responsible for the redistribution of transatlantic mail were Havana, Cartagena de Indias, Veracruz and Buenos Aires. The author examines in detail the origin of the ESPAÑA postmarks, the 14 identified types, their characteristics and application sites, with many graphic examples.
